Filmmakers gain a comprehensive overview on how to produce, finance, and distribute independent features. The seminar explores each aspect of the filmmaking process, from development (from idea to pitch to script) to packaging (raising money from private investors and foreign distributors, attaching talent, and deal making) to production (budgets, working with actors, hiring heads of departments, choosing locations according to tax incentives, delivering the movie, editing, music, and credits) and distribution (foreign and domestic, self-distribution, sales agents, and the festival circuit).
